We have fully launched into our new church theme. Until next fall our focus will be the year of *Defending the Faith!* Believers are given this command in 1 Peter 3:15.

Why this theme? Primarily, it's because I hear reports very frequently about people (mostly young adults) who were raised in Christ-centered homes, and attended Biblebelieving churches, who are now struggling with theological orthodoxy. It ought not come as a surprise to any of us that Satan is the chief deceiver. He wants to shipwreck the faith of everyone. The enemy of our souls is so focused on this that he even sought to tempt the Lord Jesus Christ into denying biblical truth (Matthew 4:1-11). Three times Satan attempted to get Jesus to sin, and three times Jesus was victorious by standing on the truth of the inspired, inerrant, and authoritative Word of God!

It's often been said: "If you don't stand for something, then you'll fall for anything." However, we must not stand for just anything, but "...for the faith which was once delivered to the saints" (Jude 3). You see, it's not man's opinion which provides power and brings freedom. It's the Gospel revealed in the Word of God which has the power to save (Romans 1:16). That's because only the truth of Scripture can set the captive free (John 8:32).

Satan knows just where to attack—at the roots. It seems that he is doing this in our day by tempting those who have a faith background, to deny biblical authority. Sin (as identified in Scripture) is no longer sin in the minds of many. By way of example, I just filled out a form for travel to another country. On the form, I was required to indicate my gender. The choices were: "male," "female," and "other." This was a federal document! I'm not too shocked when the unbelieving world is so easily duped by the Devil. What's anguishing is when those who have a history of knowing (and seemingly having believed) the Word of God, turn from the way of righteousness. Scripture gives an alarming warning to those who at one time were instructed in biblical theology, to then knowingly reject it. I offer this, not because I delight in it at all, but to warn those who have departed from the faith.

2 Peter 2:21-22 - "For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them. But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, 'The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.""

In our year of **Defending the Faith**, I purpose to give myself to this; not by spouting my own opinions, but by clearly

and passionately preaching verse-byverse through the written Word of God.
Believer: let's serve our glorious Lord
together in these last days in *Defending the Faith* in a spirit of love. May
God be pleased to continue to anoint
the ministry of the Word at RBBC.
