The RBBC 2022-23 year of being **Members One of Another** continues to be a great success! This theme has been taught, preached, and experienced by the Body of Christ at RBBC in a number of ways.

First, on Sunday mornings, I've been preaching verse-by-verse through the Book of Philippians. This is the most personal of Paul's Epistles. This is truly a Bible book about the value of being **Members One of Another**. This, combined with soul-stirring worship music, is always a "must-attend" for believers each week. Invite a friend!

Second, our new Small Group ministry finished the initial year of meetings, and is about ready to begin year two. This ministry typically meets in homes once a week for the purpose of fellowship, edification, and the integration of the lives of brothers/sisters in Christ. In fact, the Small Group Mission Statement is: *"To form and foster lifelong close biblical relationships with accountability among church members."* Those interested in being part of a Small Group should go to the Church Center app, click on Small Groups on the homepage, and get started by completing the form.

Third, many times throughout the summer, God's people have met at the pavilion following the evening service. These times have been filled with food, fun, & fellowship!

Fourth, the theme of being **Members One of Another** would be incomplete without consistent times of corporate prayer. RBBC men meet every Tuesday morning at 7 AM. Our ladies meet on Wednesdays at 10 AM. Of course, the churchwide prayer time is every Wednesday at 6:30 PM. Be sure to regularly be part of a time of prayer with fellow Red Bridgers.

Fifth, Sunday School has always been an important time of joining hearts together for discussion around the Word of God. This is always a great time to spiritually sharpen one another (Prov.27:17). We have classes for all ages, so be sure to arrive on Sunday mornings before 9:15 AM, to join a Bible study class. The adult opening assembly meets in the West Wing to begin the Sunday School hour.

Finally, our children/youth ministry has featured Awana ("Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed") for nearly three decades. Awana starts up again on Sept. 6, and meets each Wednesday evening from 6:30-8:30 PM.

Being **Members One of Another** is not just a slogan at RBBC. It's really what it means to experience life in the family of God. In these end-times, live out your life in service to our Lord by serving Him in/through His church (Heb.10:24-25). May God continue to have His hand of blessing upon RBBC!
